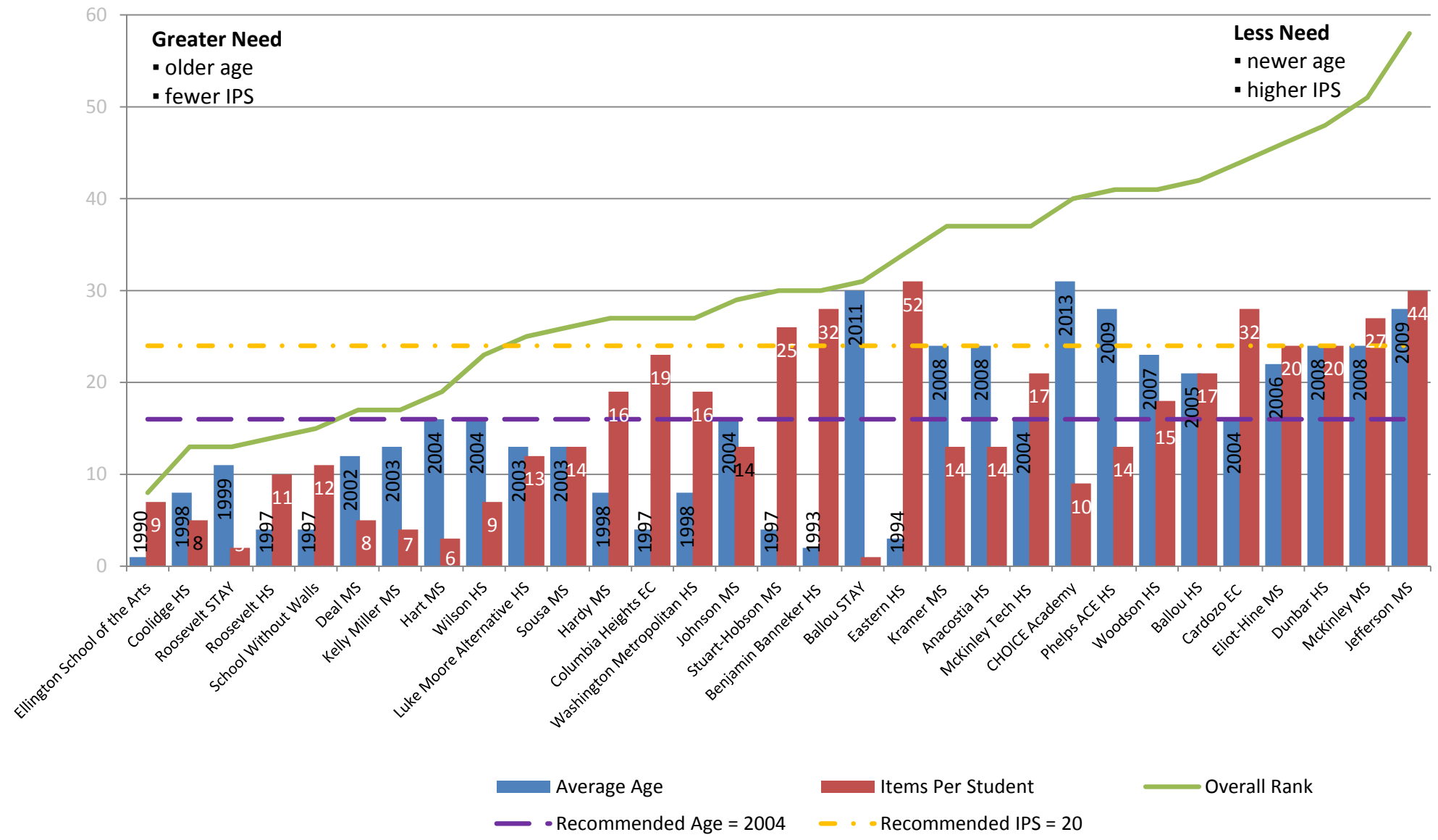

District of Columbia Secondary Schools Combined Need-Based Ranking



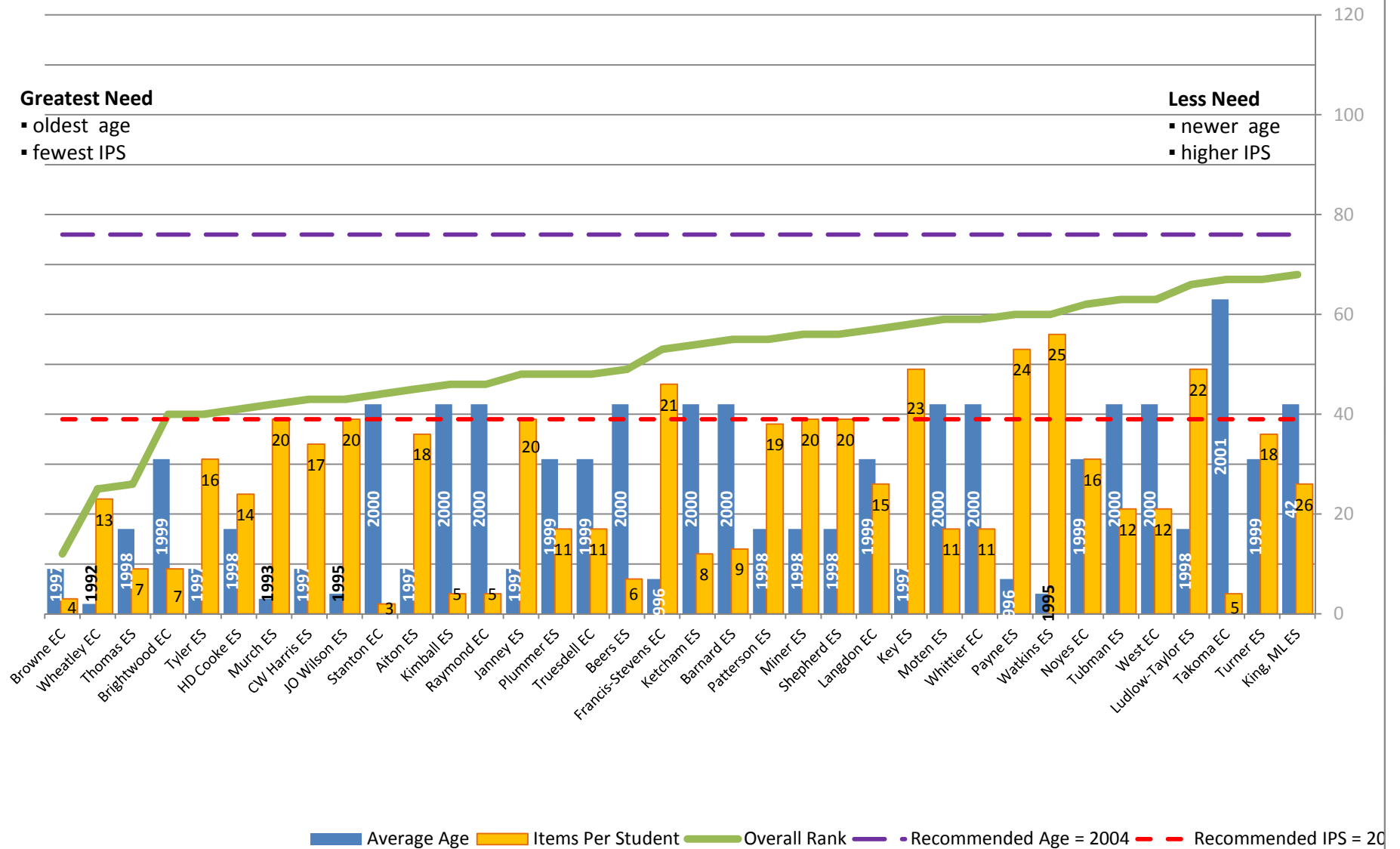
