




Dear PAVE Parents, Friends, and Supporters,

Your hard work has truly paid off! Today the DC Council took their final vote to pass the FY19 Budget, including \$20.25 million for OST programs - an increase of nearly \$10.56 million!

**At our PAVE Parent Policy Summit a year ago**, you told us that increased access to affordable and high-quality Out of School (OST) Time Programs for DC students was a top priority for you. For all the hard work you have done organizing your communities to advocate for high-quality programs across DC, we say, 'THANK YOU!'

This historic increase happened because parents and advocates - like you - collectively amplified your voices and called on our city leaders to invest in our kids. You sent letters, signed petitions, advocated at the Mayor's budget forums, testified at public hearings, and shared the message with your communities. Your voices were heard, driving real change for DC families.

# Increases in OST Funding in FY19 (in millions)



This additional funding will bring us even closer to ensuring every child in DC has access to a quality afterschool and summer program. To further support equitable access, PAVE parents surveyed over 1,000 DC families to determine the greatest needs and barriers for OST programs. The Deputy Mayor of Education's office will use this information to make sure this funding goes towards the programs and areas that need it most, putting parent voice at the front and center of the decision-making conversation.



But even with this historic win, there is still a long way to go in order to make sure every child in DC has access to enriching programs and a safe, healthy, and welcoming school environment.

That's why PAVE parents came together again at the PAVE Parent Policy Summit this month to choose the education issues they will focus their advocacy on next school year. Nearly 150 parents from across the city voted 'Transparent Citywide School Funding' and 'Mental Health Supports and Trauma-Informed Training for All Schools' as their top two issues areas. This year, PAVE parent leaders will once again take the lead by amplifying these issues and ensuring their voices help shape our policy.




