

# SY17-18 EASTERN HIGH SCHOOL BOUNDARY CAPTURE AND ENROLLMENT

In total 2,587 Middle and High School aged students live in Eastern's boundary and attend a public school somewhere in the District. Only 531 or 21% of that population choose Eastern, Eliot-Hine, Jefferson or Stuart Hobson. Eastern High School's rapid change in enrollment is due in part to the school's restructuring, which phased out grades and reopened in in 2011 to a new freshman class.
