Dear DCPS Family,

As you begin summer break, DC Public Schools is working with partners to introduce a new app to help your student build their reading skills all summer long. The app is called Amira, and it's designed to be a personalized reading tutor.

The Amira app is available for DCPS students going into grades 2-5 for School Year 2021-2022. Your child is ready to read with the app if they can read a simple story, including 3-letter words (e.g., can, mom, bag) and high-frequency sight words (e.g., am, see, is) on their own without adult help.

To use Amira, access the app using your student's Clever login and the software recommends stories for them to read. As your child reads aloud, Amira listens. When she sees an opportunity to reinforce a reading skill, Amira provides personalized help, drawing from more than 30 different research-based tutoring techniques, developed by childhood reading experts.

Children who read and participate in learning activities for at least 20 minutes a day, including through Amira, will be eligible to receive recognition and prizes. For more information, please visit dcibrary.org/summerchallenge. Students who sign up for DCPL's Summer Challenge can also log their time in Amira to earn a special Amira badge, and it will also count toward their Read20 goal.

As your child reads and grows with Amira, it will help them know that:

- 1. Reading is fun!
- 2. It's okay to make mistakes.
- 3. It's okay to not know all the words! They should try their best to sound out words or skip them if
